- I will use those coaching techniques appropriate for all of the skills that I teach.
- I will remember that I am a youth sports coach, and that the game is for the children and not adults.

I understand that as a coach in the Cary Pop Warner organization, I am a volunteer of the organization for the 2011 Pop Warner football season only. I am to follow all league policies and procedures as defined by Cary Pop Warner Football and Cheerleading, the Cary Pop Warner commissioner/cheer director, the Consolidated Football Federation and the National Pop Warner Little Scholars rulebook. At all league practices, games and events, I, as a Cary Pop Warner coach, will act as a positive role model to all association members and participants.
